Block Dyslexia Screening

£60 per pupil

Max. 4 pupils per day booking, each screening lasts about 1 1/2 hours and provides an **indication** if the pupil has dyslexia and on what level.

Our screening service uses the LUCID Rapid Screening computer programme, which tests working memory, phonological processing and visual-verbal integration memory (5–7 years) or phonic decoding skills (8-15 years), looking at the areas of difficulty that are most common to dyslexic children. Also used is LASS and an analysis of handwriting. The Rapid Screening assessment together with a consultation with the specialist trained assessor may also include testing for visual difficulties using coloured overlays if this seems appropriate.

1:1 in-school support

Specialist dyslexia trained tutor to work with a dyslexic child in a specific lesson.

2 hour session with 1 hour feedback session 6 weeks later run by a specialist trained dyslexia assessor. Aimed at Teachers, SENCO's, HLTA's and Senior TA's. The course shows how to develop a 'snapshot' of pupils who possibly have dyslexia. Ways to identify a pattern of their strengths and weakness to build a plan of action using our Dyslexia Handbook

School INSET Dyslexia Awareness Training Course £250

2 hour session run by a specialist trained dyslexia teacher. Aimed at staff and volunteers working in schools including Head teachers, SENCO's, teachers, teaching assistants and learning support staff. The course provides a better understanding of dyslexia, how it can be identified and then supported by strategies and techniques to use with the pupils.

Touch typing support classes (per session) £60

45 minute session for pupils aged between 7 - 12 (up to 10 pupils). School to provide computers/software, WFDA recommends Typequick. Pupils will have targets to reach for each level of the programme. Flexibility on session time.

NB For schools out of the LBWF travel costs could be incurred.
