The Importance of Disability Inclusive language

The session will introduce colleagues to the STAART Principles of Disability (SPoD): how and why the SPoD was created, and who created these principles.

Dr Melanie Thorley is the STAART Manager at the University of Greenwich and a Director and Trustee of AchieveAbility. STAART supports students with a disability, long-term health condition, neurodivergence (autistic and dyslexic spectra), and/or mental health condition to thrive at university.

Melanie will discuss negative/pejorative language to avoid and the importance of disability inclusive language.
